Recommendation & Key Reasons

The proposed scheme is for the erection of up to 50 dwellings on the site with associated access and landscaping works. The proposed development **does** exceed the relevant thresholds stated in Schedule 2 of the EIA Regulations. These areas have been addressed in line with the EIA Regulations and Government guidance and it has been concluded that likely significant effects would not occur. It is therefore recommended that the proposed scheme **does not** constitute <u>EIA development</u>.

The proposal is considered to fall within EIA Regulations, Schedule 2 paragraph 10B.

The proposed scheme <u>exceeds</u> the relevant thresholds given in Schedule 2 of the EIA Regulations for Infrastructure Projects as the site area exceeds 0.5ha.

The proposed scheme <u>does</u> exceed the relevant thresholds set for Infrastructure Projects in the Government's guidance (circular 02/99) on EIA. However, it is concluded that the development would not result in significant environmental impacts.

Description of the proposal

Physical development

The proposal is for the erection of up to 50 dwellings on site, with associated access and landscaping works. The applicant proposes a mix of dwellings on the site, to be confirmed at a later stage.

Site description

The site comprises a piece of land, set back from Frensham Vale and measuring

approximately 10.3 hectares. The site appears well treed, and slopes away from the road in a series of gradients. The site currently contains two residential properties. To the east of the site is residential development; to the west, open countryside. The site is semi-rural in character.

Considerations against Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 of the EIA Regulations

Is the proposal listed in Schedule 1?

The scheme would not involve a form of development listed in Schedule 1.

Is the proposal listed in Schedule 2?

The proposal is considered to fall within EIA Regulations, Schedule 2 paragraph 10B (Infrastructure Projects) _____

Does the proposal exceed the relevant thresholds given in the EIA regulations?

Yes – the site area would exceed 0.5ha.

Does the proposal exceed the relevant thresholds given in the official guidance on EIA (Circular 2/99)?

Yes – paragraphs A18 and A20 advise that development of more than 5 hectares, or which generate a significant increase in traffic, noise, emissions to air and water are more likely to require EIA.

Is the proposal in or adjacent to a sensitive area as defined in Schedule 2 of the EIA Regulations?

No – the site is not within or adjacent to a 'sensitive area' within the definition of the Regulations.

Is the proposal in or within 2.5km of a site designated under the Birds Directive (SPA) the Habitats Directive (SAC) or the Ramsar Convention?

The application site is within the Wealden Heath I SPA 5km Buffer Zone and Wealden Heaths I SAC 2km Buffer Zone but does not fall within the actual SPA or SAC. It may be necessary to screen the development for appropriate assessment given number of units proposed prior to application (>50).

Is the proposal in or adjacent to other potentially sensitive areas, such as local designations, protected species, contaminated land, etc?

The application site is not covered by any areas of the following areas designated at the local level for landscape or conservation (e.g. Area of Great Landscape Value (AGLV), Sites of Nature Conservation Importance (SNCI), or Local Nature Reserves

(LNRs). It is, however, adjacent to an area of potentially contaminated land and Ancient Woodland.
