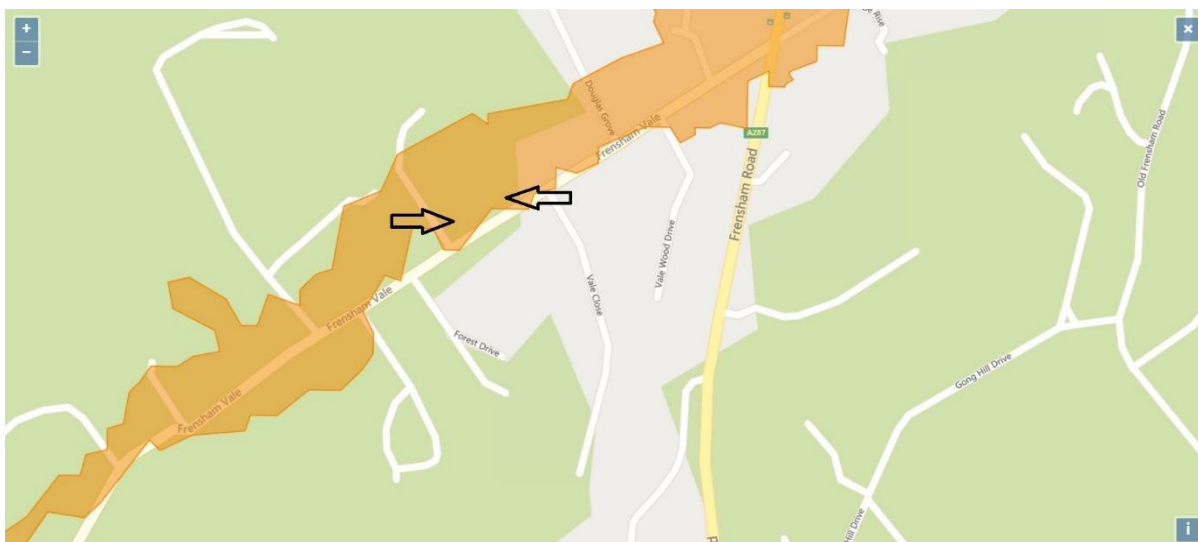
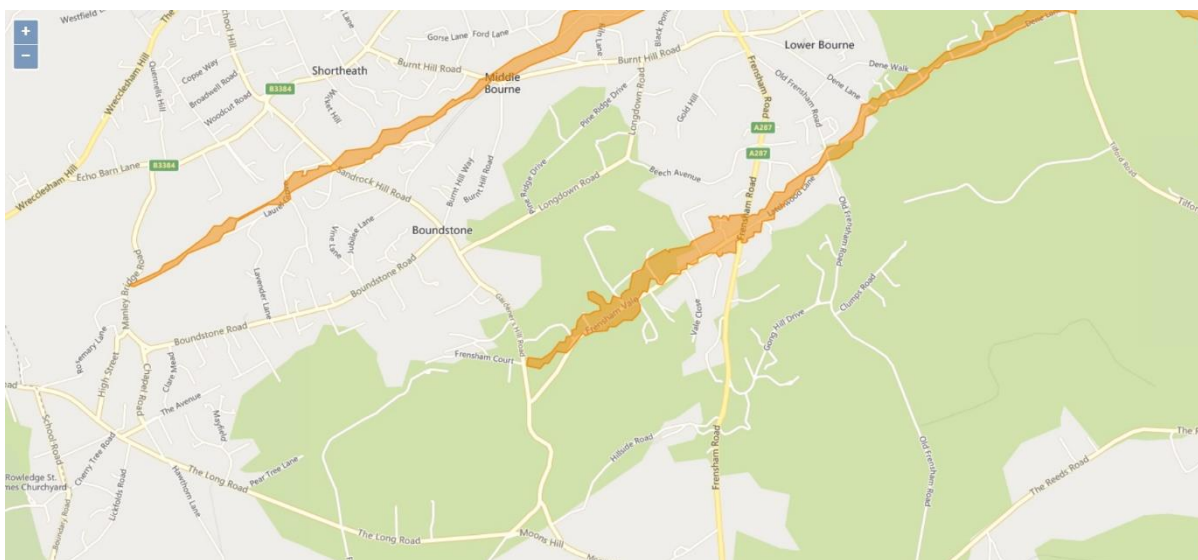


# Flood alert in force now Upper River Wey

## Flooding is possible - be prepared

Property flooding is not currently expected. River levels are high on the River Wey as a result of persistent heavy rainfall over the weekend. Therefore, flooding of roads and farmland is expected to continue over the coming days, especially in the Tilford area. River levels are falling in the upper reaches, but now rising in the Godalming area as water makes its way through the river system. Flooding of properties is not forecast at this point. Further rainfall is forecast this morning (05/10/20), with the potential to be heavy at times. We are closely monitoring the situation. Our incident response staff have been in the area clearing trash screens. Please remain safe and aware of your local surroundings and avoid using low lying footpaths near local watercourses. This message will be updated this evening, (05/10/20) or as the situation changes.
